Competitive Expenses

Competitive Soccer differs in many ways from recreational soccer both for the player and for the parent. Below is a list of the fees and the types of expenses that are covered by each.

1. **WCSC Registration: \$105.00 entire year** - Fees go to OSA, GCSA and WCSC for insurance, field maintenance, referees, etc.
 2. **FC Bartlesville Competitive program: \$20 – One time annual fee** - To be applied to team equipment that will stay with the team. This money will be deposited directly into the team account and the equipment requests will be made by the coach.
 3. **FC Bartlesville Monthly dues: \$60/Month - 10 Months Aug - May** covers each team's Coach/Training fees, FCB Goalkeeper training fee, and DOC/Assistant DOC fee.
 4. **FCB Adidas Uniform set: Approx. \$125.00** - Includes 2 pair of shorts (1 navy 1 white), 2 game jerseys (1 navy 1 white), 1 practice jersey (additional practice jerseys may be purchased), 2 pairs of socks (1 navy and 1 white). Optional and/or additional pieces may be purchased if desired (Ball Bags \$36, Warm Ups \$76). Uniforms are used minimum of two years. Prices are subject to change year to year, uniform prices are only given as approximates.
 5. **Tournament costs: Approx. \$700** - The number of tournaments attended during a season and the location of the tournaments will be determined by the coach. A typical team, depending on the group of players and the age of the team, will attend two tournaments per season. During these tournaments the coach's hotel room and travel expenses will be paid by the team. Your team's entry fee to a tournament ranges from \$400-\$600 depending on the tournament. As an estimate we will consider that a given team attends four tournaments per year. Each season one will be a local Tulsa tournament and the other will be an out of town tournament requiring a two hotel night stay.
- Note: On average the costs to play competitive will be \$150 per month for 10 months. Some suggestions to help defray costs would be carpooling, rooming with other players if the entire family does not travel to a tournament, and team fundraising.
